
Since 2013, The Centre of Study and research on Disaster is strengthen the relation between the academy and public administration seeking advances in the disaster risks management to the Paraná State.

Águas de Março

Disaster of March 11th 2011

- ✓ 234.8 mm of rainfall accumulated in 48 hours;
- ✓ Peak of 40 mm per hour;
- ✓ More than 28,000 affected people;
- ✓ 7 towns;
- ✓ More than 2,500 accidents;
- ✓ Estimated cost of USD 120 million



The disaster spotted the points

- ✓ Increasing of disaster frequency and extreme events in Brazil and Paraná State;
- ✓ Focus on the actions of response and the institutions integration difficulty;
- ✓ Decisions took without technical-scientific base;
- ✓ Distance between research, teaching and management;
- ✓ Lack of knowledge the disasters impact.





REDESASTRE

"In the municipalities of Paraná, Brazil, CEPED promoted the Resilient Cities Campaign as a tool to strengthen risk management capacities. The University Center launched a network of 23 public and private sector institutions at the state, federal, and international levels, called REDESASTRE.

This is the first thematic network officially established in Brazil to promote cooperation and scientific and technological exchange with the aim of reducing disaster risk. Thanks to its plurality of components, the network has proven to be a success and a valuable resource for over 80% of municipalities in Paraná that aim to promote resilience in their cities.






